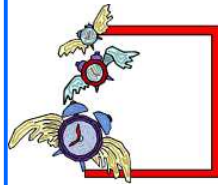

Monthly Demo: Our demo for February, 2009 was given by John Lucas on turning a captured ring goblet. John talked on how to make tools out of things like screw drivers and other things. John started by turning the bowl of the goblet first and then turned the rings around the stem. He suggested to turn more rings than needed as they do break very easy when turning. After turning the ring, he taped it to the bowl to prevent it from breaking while he finished the stem and base. He also showed us how to sand the inside of the ring by taping sandpaper to the unfinished stem.





Safety Tip Of The Month:

Prior to running your lathe in reverse, make sure that necessary steps are taken to prevent the work piece and /or chuck from unscrewing itself from the lathe.
