The Cumberland Woodturners met on January 26, 2005 at the workshop of Bill and Jackie Westerbeck. Vice President John Lucas called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. There were 23 members present, including 3 new members.

MONTHLY PROGRAM

This month's program was a demonstration of Fluted Turnings by Everett Elkins. Everett demonstrated several methods for fluting a bowl. For any method, the first action is to layout the number of flute divisions on the bowl. This can be done using the lathe indexing head, a homemade indexing jig, or simply a fabric measuring tape wrapped around the rim of the bowl.

With a bowl attached to the lathe headstock, Everett used a homemade riser table on the lathe bed to slide a horizontally-mounted laminate router into the bowl to cut the flutes.

He also demonstrated several off-lathe tools, including a flexible shaft rotary carver using a

Typhoon bit and small sanding drums, and a reciprocating carver using Flexcut gouge bits. Typhoon and Flexcut brands are very good, and are available through Woodcraft or woodcarving supply catalogs. Everett also showed that a hand drill could be used with the rotary bits, as long as the workpiece is held securely. All the machines Everett demonstrated used a footpedal speed controller for safety.

Collaboration Challenge

Guidelines:

- Maximum Size: 9" diameter x 10" length
- Leave the mounting area intact (tenon for chuck or faceplate, waste block, etc).
- Bring your partially turned piece to the March meeting.
- Pieces will be assigned numbers, and those who brought a piece will draw a number and take that piece to complete.
- If you don't have the equipment to work on the piece you draw, arrangements will be made to swap pieces with someone, borrow equipment, etc..
- Bring the completed piece to the April meeting.
