Safety Tip Of The Month: Make certain that the belt guard and/or control and motor covers are in place. Check to make sure all tightening handles are properly tightened. Make sure that the tool is resting on the tool rest before beginning the cut. Always run the lathe at slow speeds while making roughing cuts and NEVER use a roughing gouge on a bowl.
