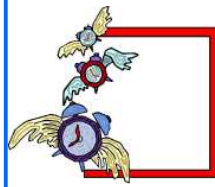

Monthly Demo:



This months demo was given by Dennis Anderson on making "Ring Holders". Ring Holders are used to hold ladies (and men's) rings while washing hands or dishes and can be used on dressers

to store rings not being worn. Dennis showed us how easy they can be made out of small pieces of wood. The wood is held with a tennon in a chuck and the tailstock. The tail stock is not used after parting off the small end of the ring holder. When done turning, the large end is parted off with a little taper in the bottom so they will set flat.
