More discussion on having Richard Raffan, from Australia, doing a demo in the spring of 2010. Jim Bentley proposed that we do a craft showing at Fairfield Glade And was agreed on by the membership. Paul Todd discussed the possibility of having a booth at next years Cumberland County Fair. He was given the okay by the members to investigate this further.

Rod Smith reported that we need a lot more ornaments, tops and yoyos made and donated to the club for selling and for the Christmas Tree at the bank. The club raised over \$800 in the past year with these items.

Another very good demo was given by Les Black on kaleidoscope eggs. The challenge of the month was voted on, the raffle was held and the meeting was adjourned.



Monthly Demo:

Les Black gave us another great demo on making kaleidoscope eggs. He showed us how to laminate and cut thin strips of wood. These should be about 21". When you cut one strip from the laminated piece, it will make one egg when cut at 2 1/2". He talked about gluing pieces that are cut on a 22.5 degree angle. The rough length should be 2 1/2" and the finished length is 2 1/4". A 13/16" hole is drilled in the center for mounting the inside parts. Les showed us how to assemble the parts before installing them in the egg.

Directions to Jon & Kerri Reiver's Farm - 3501 Brewer RD

From Fair Field Glade/ I-40 Exit 322 Make a right off ramp.

Continue on road (Miller Bypass 392) through Stop sign. Continue through traffic light. At second traffic light make a left on **101 South (Lantana RD)** About 7 miles south of town you will see a cemetery and old brick school house on left. Slow down. Around a sharp curve you will see a big white Lantana Church of Christ on the right. Turn left on **Vandever Rd** opposite the church Approximately 5 miles latter you will see a corner with a white/gray mini-mart and gas station on the right Turn Right on **Brewer RD** just before the mini-mart Go 3.5 miles I am on the left, double gates, gravel RD, 3501 on mail box, Submarine on post above mail box, red small barn in field.

From 127 (Pikeville)

Go up onto the plateau from Pikeville Turn left on **Vandever** (just before the pond on the left after you cross Big Daddy Creek) Go 5.5 Miles Turn left on **Brewer Rd** just after Grey corner "Vandever Grocery store/mini-mart". Go 3.5 miles I am on the left, double gates, gravel RD, 3501 on mail box, Submarine on post above mail box, red small barn in field
