Mystery Box Winner was Tim Audette. He won a beautiful Pen from Roy Cuff.

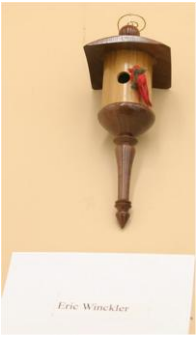
