## Demo on turning a Pen by Ken Walker

---

Ken talked about casting your own pen blanks, using other materials for blanks like stabilized wood, deer antler, dyed wood, acrylics, etc. He demonstrated the proper method drilling the hole for the brass insert, using CA glue or epoxy to hold the brass, turning the wood blanks, sanding and finishing on the lathe, and the assembly. Thank you Ken for a fine demo.



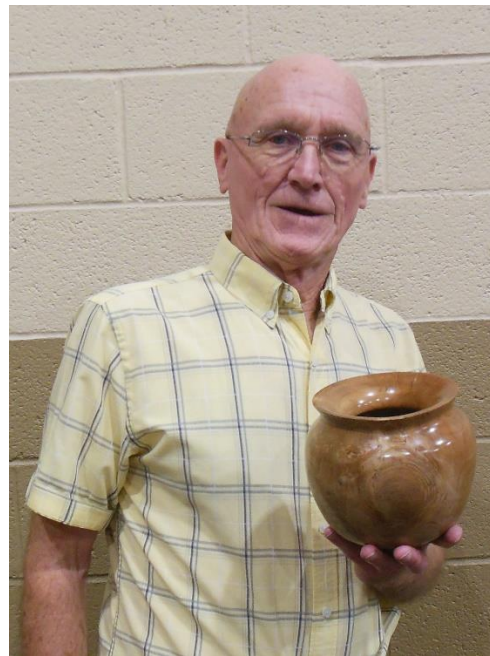
