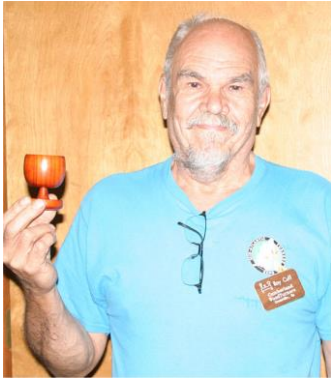

Business meeting:

2. Old Business:

- a. Motion to accept the Minutes as published in the May Newsletter was accepted.
- b. Motion to accept the Treasurer's report via email in advance of the meeting was accepted. General fund \$4126. Charity \$85.
