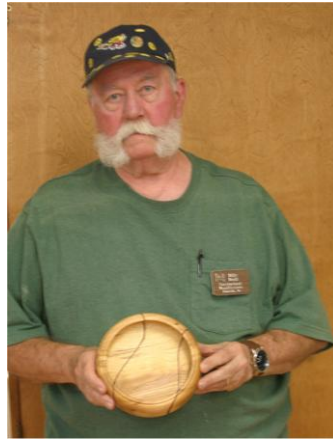
Mystery Box Winner was Jon Reiver. He won a beautiful Bowl made by Tom Neckvatal

2. Old Business:
