**New Business:**

1. **Free ride (or almost free ride) for 1-week Arrowmont class!** Cumberland Woodturners has been awarded a full tuition scholarship to Arrowmont worth \$852 for a one week class for fall 2025. The free tuition coupled with \$500 from the club and proceeds from the \$10 raffle should pay most, if not all of the Room and Board. Any excess will be returned to the club treasury. The drawing will be at the May meeting after raffle inputs are closed. The winner should be on the Arrowmont website on 2 June at 9 AM to sign up. 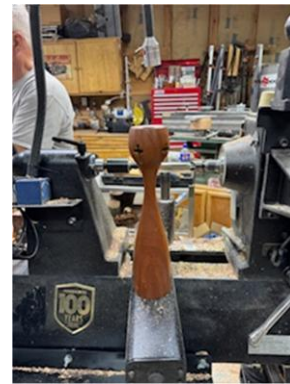
